# Week 1: Botany Camp

This week, your children will become young botanists! Botany is the scientific study of plant life. As a branch of biology, it is also sometimes referred to as plant sciences or plant biology. Botany covers a wide range of scientific disciplines that study the growth, reproduction, metabolism, development, diseases, and evolution of plants. Through a variety of hands-on activities like scientific research projects, arts & crafts, games, drama activities, manual activities, etc., your children will learn all about botany, plant life cycles, plant cells, plants' needs, & more!

#### Week 2: Hansel & Gretel Drama Camp

This week we will delve into the realm of 'show business' as we explore a 'scripted reality TV show' version of The Grimm Brother's fairy tale Hansel and Gretel. "Hansel and Gretel are a brother and sister abandoned in a forest, where they fall into the hands of a Scary Witch who lives in a house made of candy. How will they ever make it home, but more importantly, is the Scary Witch really the one they should be afraid of?"

Students will journey through this fractured fairy tale with many twists and turns to the original classic as you know it.

Using dark comedy, we will explore familial fairy-tale archetypes and work to develop characterizations through themes like 'good vs. evil', 'being out of your comfort zone', and 'making the journey back home'. The week will be packed with various games and activities; as well as singing, dancing, and arts and crafts. Each student will eventually have their own role to play, all while working together to put on a full production at the end of the five days.



## Week 3: Help! I Need a Vacation Musical Drama Camp

This week we will put on our sunglasses, grab our favorite beach gear, and delve into Musical Theatre as we explore John Jacobson's liberating musical "Help! I Need a Vacation!"

"Schoolwork, choir rehearsal, track practice, plus my paper route?! How can I possibly get all of this done!?! I NEED A VACATION!!

Whether it's a relaxing fishing hole or thrilling rides at your favorite theme park, this allschool revue explores all the possibilities for the perfect vacation."Students will work through this musical story through various 'vacation' themed games and activities, including imagination and role-playing exercises, arts and crafts, and singing and dancing to songs like the famous 'Take Me Out To The Ball Game', 'A Letter From Camp', and the hit title song 'Help! I Need A Vacation', etc. Each student will eventually have their own role to play, all while working together to put on a full production at the end of the five days.



## Week 4: Art Mediums Camp

This week, your children will be making art using different kinds of art mediums. Each day, we will focus on a particular medium. Your children will learn all about each medium and then do several projects throughout the day using the different art mediums.

Your children will do a variety of activities during these 3 days, including science experiments, scientific research projects, arts & crafts, games, drama activities, manual activities, & more!
