Week 1: The Princess Bride Drama Camp

This week we will take to the stage to explore the comedic and 'not so average fairytale' satire of William Goldman's "The Princess Bride". "While home sick in bed, a young boy's grandfather reads him the story of a farmboy-turned-pirate who encounters numerous obstacles, enemies and allies in his quest to be reunited with his true love."

A story which strays from the normal parameters of a fairytale, and has promised to include "fencing, fighting, revenge, giants, monsters, chases, escapes, true love, miracles ...", students will explore this adventurous story through character building, fairy-tale archetypes, and 'slap-stick' comedy.

Each student will eventually have their own role to play, all while working together to put on a full production at the end of the five days.

Information Cont.

If your children are coming for morning day-care/garderie, one of our staff will be waiting to receive them at the front door starting from 9h30. If you arrive for day-care after 9h40, please call either me (at the number above) or Tori at 06.88.49.93.13 so that one of us may meet you at the front door. If your children are not signed up for morning day-care, one of our staff will be waiting to receive them at the front door starting from 10h00. If you arrive after 10h15, please call one of the numbers listed above so that one of our staff may meet you at the front door.

We have a refrigerator and microwaves at SAME Club, which allow us to preserve your children's lunch until it is time to eat as well as reheat their lunch for lunchtime. You do not have to send your children with an afternoon snack, as it will be provided by us.

With the current rising health situation, we would like for you to note:

- If a child presents symptoms of being unwell (fever, cough, etc.), we can refuse to accept them into our establishment until they are better or ask for them to receive a covid test.
- Regular hand washing will be asked of the children. Please inform them to respect this procedure.



Personal Items

Your children must take off their shoes when they come indoors. If you would like them to wear slippers inside, please pack a pair for them to use.

For children in the 3-6 age group, please provide your children with an extra set of clothes, just in case.

***** We have a lot of messy activities planned during our Holiday Camps. Please do NOT send your children in clothes that need to be kept clean and protected, as they will be using paints and other messy art supplies as well as playing around outdoors. *****

Please label all of your children's personal items (backpacks, lunchboxes, water bottles, hats, clothes, etc) with their first and last name to ensure that it is not lost throughout the week.



Bloomz Application

At SAME Club, we use the Bloomz application to keep you informed on your children's activities throughout our holiday camps. Join your children's teachers and other classroom parents in a closed environment. Your children's information security is important to us, so their names and images are protected, and teachers control parents' access and verification. Easily track your children's activities, classroom events, and more. With classroom instant messaging, photo updates, announcements, and alerts, Bloomz is a powerful virtual communication tool. During the camps, I will be sending you an invitation to join your children's Bloomz group, where you will get daily updates on the activities your children have participated in. You will need to download the Bloomz application and create an account to join the group and to receive updates.
