# Week 1: Teen Drama Camp

## **Week 3: Buggin' Out Camp**

**This week is all about insects! Your children will become entomologists (bug scientists!) and learn about what insects are, different types of insects, the parts of an insect, life-cycles of insects, and a whole lot more through science activities, arts & crafts, manual activities, games, exploration, & more!**





# **Week 4: Under the Sea Camp**

*Under the sea, under the sea...*

The ocean is a vast and magical place. This will be a week filled with ocean-themed activities. Your children will learn about life under the sea and the ocean itself through arts & crafts, games, creative activities, manual activities, & more!

# **Week 5: King Arthur Drama Camp**

*This week we will take to the stage and travel back in time to explore the legendary story of "King Arthur". "Frustrated of living in a Medieval mess, Merlin uses all his magical powers to change a skinny little boy into a legendary hero."*

*Students will delve into the mystical world of Camelot and journey the famous tales of King Arthur through various Medieval themed activities. These will include characterizations of Kings and Queens, Warriors and Fairies, Witches and Wizards, as well as singing, dancing, and arts and crafts. Each student will eventually have their own role to play, all while working together to put on a full production at the end of the five days.*



# Week 6: STEAM Camp

What is STEAM? STEAM stands for science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics. STEAM for children falls under the umbrella of *inquiry instruction*. Inquiry instruction encourages active, hands-on experiences that support building understanding, critical thinking, problem solving, communication, and reflection. Throughout the week, your children will be doing many STEAM projects that use all of these skills. STEAM activities take many forms, all of which are beneficial for children.



# **Week 7: Drama Acting Camp**

This week, we will be doing 'animal work' acting workshops, where we will explore more in-depth this method/technique to acting through various exercises. We will apply this to selected scenes from Raold Dahl's 'Matilda', where the students can showcase their work and what they have learned. Throughout the week, the children will participate in various drama workshops, games, arts & craft activities, and more!
